Kansas Education Systems Accreditation (hereafter "KESA") is a district-wide

accreditation process. Accreditation within this process is ultimately granted

by the Kansas State Board of Education. The district school board (hereafter

"board") shall maintain the goal of full accreditation for the district. Good

faith efforts shall be made by all staff to implement district school improve-

ment plans. The board shall monitor compliance.

The board is committed to implementing and sustaining the foundational

structures defined within the KESA process as well as defining and imple-

menting district-wide goals in alignment with the KESA rubrics.

In order for accreditation to be achieved, the board shall commit to

school improvement for all district schools, academic achievement for all dis-

trict students, and results-based professional development for all district staff

members. The superintendent shall regularly report to the board on the dis-

trict's progress toward full accreditation within the 5 year cycle defined as

part of the KESA process.

The board shall fully inform the public in languages commonly used in

the community about district-wide goals, school improvement plans, the pro-

gress of school improvement efforts, the accreditation status of the district,

and other pertinent information as the board may direct.
